



## 2017 Belgium Internship

### Dates:

- June 1 – August 7, 2017
- SportQuest Leadership Training Weekend: June 1-4, 2017 (required)
- Depart U.S. for Belgium: June 4, 2017
- SportQuest Belgium Project Dates: July 11 – 30, 2017
- Additional SportQuest Project Week in Brakel: July 31 – August 4, 2017
- Depart Belgium for U.S.: August 7, 2017

### Costs:

- **SportQuest Belgium Project Cost: \$1,995.00 + travel**
- **SportQuest Leadership Training Weekend Cost: \$125 + travel**
  - Cost includes all conference materials, meals, and lodging. The Leadership Training Weekend is required for all interns. This cost will be added to your project invoice and can be fundraised.
  - This will take place at Camp Y'Shua in Lawton, OK. SQ will work with you to book and arrange travel at no additional cost.
- **Additional Internship Cost: \$475**
  - This cost covers a portion of your food and living expenses each week apart from the SportQuest Belgium Project weeks. This cost will be added to your project invoice and can be fundraised. Host families and SportQuest Belgium Staff help keep the weekly costs low.
- **International Airfare:** Because you will travel on your own, you will need to make arrangements for your round-trip international transportation to and from Brussels, Belgium (BRU). This cost is separate from your SportQuest Belgium project cost. If you raise more than enough funds to cover your project cost, the remaining funds can be reimbursed for you to purchase airfare. A detailed receipt and a \$5 processing fee will be required.
  - Step 1:** Contact the SportQuest office before booking your domestic travel to confirm flight itinerary.
  - Step 2:** Once flight itinerary has been confirmed, book your flight ASAP to ensure availability and get the best price.
  - Step 3:** Fill out the International Airfare Form that SportQuest will email you and return this with a copy of your flight itinerary either by mail or via email.
- **Miscellaneous Funds:** Spending money for souvenirs, gifts, recreational activities, meals out, etc...

### Living Situation:

- Christian Belgian host families connected with SportQuest Belgium

### Transportation:

- Host family, SportQuest Belgium Staff, train, bike, bus, etc.
- Majority of travel expenses covered in living expense cost. Could be an occasional personal expense, especially for recreational activities.

### Responsibilities:

- Provide support and service to the SportQuest Belgium Staff
- Planning and preparing for the SportQuest Belgium Projects
- Serving partner churches
- Helping with follow-up programs (discipling and encouraging youth)
- Involvement in local ministry
- Tasks might range from administrative duties and office work to setting up training camp facilities, leading training camp workshops, Bible studies and helping to plan and prepare for the SportQuest Belgium project.
- Possible leadership roles on teams during summer project.

Besides providing support and service to the SportQuest Belgium Staff, interns will be challenged to grow personally in their own spiritual walk, leadership abilities, and relational skills. Structure will be given for interns to develop in these ways through times of prayer and worship, living in community, reading assignments, involvement in a local church, and working alongside experienced missionaries and ministry leaders. A special focus will be given to help interns process their experiences and help them discern the callings and giftings God has given them. There will also be time for recreation, rest, and some sightseeing along the way.
